His office is totally computerized – including his x-ray equipment. He no longer uses needles for anesthetic purposes and hasn't used mercury in any of his work for many years. Over the years, Dr. Stelmaschuk has taken numerous courses to remain at the top of his field. In the 1980's, he was President of the International Association of Orthodontics – Western Canada. Through this organization, he was instrumental in bringing in guest lecturers in the field of Orthodontics to British Columbia.
